- Provided a school uniform ordering service and also attending P1 intake evenings.
- Parent/Carers volunteers helping during outdoor learning and school trips.
- Fancy Dress disco 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> November raised £610.87
- Christmas Card project raises £125.50
- Family Portraits raised £380.
- Christmas Craft & Coffee morning raised £3397
- Christmas movie night 21<sup>st</sup> December raised £391.44
- P7 End of year celebration. 15Th& 16<sup>th</sup> June 2017. The PPPC provided each pupil with a commemorative mug with the name of P7 pupils and teachers on them.
