OUR PLAN FOR 24/25

Invite more speakers and have more activities in school to save on cost. Discrete signposting for financial assistance. Promotion of credit union savings in school.

WE PROVIDED:

Gifted jumpers for all P1s. Food larder outside. Stationery in classes provided. School breakfast clubs/lunches p1 - 5. Recycled uniforms. Fruit and snack provided for break times. More signposting for grants and assistance.

OUR PLAN FOR 24/25

Better community links for food larder donations. Invite Advice Shop to come into school for drop in sessions to improve knowledge about support available.

WE PROVIDED:

After school and lunch time clubs offered by teachers. Funtastic Friday skills development opportunity for all.

OUR PLAN 24/25

Continue to offer lunch time and afterschool clubs where possible. Source specialist free/low cost activity provision/taster sessions eg martial arts, dance clubs.
